The Parker County Historical Commission (PCHC) is an agency of county government by authority of Texas Local Government Code Chapter 318, and operated under the guidelines of the Texas Historical Commission. The membership of the PCHC is charged to identify, protect, preserve, and record those elements of our local history which reflect the lives, commerce, architecture, and important events of our County. This responsibility is one to be taken seriously and with dedication.

Appointments are approved by the Parker County Commissioners Court, and are for a term of two years beginning in January of odd-numbered years, or at any time to fill vacancies. Prospective appointees must express a sincere interest in the preservation of county history and must be willing to comply with attendance requirements.

It is the policy of the PCHC to provide equal opportunity without regard to age, race, color, religion, disability, gender or national origin in all programs and services it may provide. This equal opportunity policy extends from the appointment selection process to the volunteer opportunities this organization may offer.
