

IMPORTANT NOTICE: CONVERSION TO RE:SEARCHTX FOR CIVIL CASES ONLY

In accordance with [Supreme Court Order Misc. Docket No. 24-9030](#) and [Court of Criminal Appeals Misc. Docket no. 24-004](#), the District Clerk and County Clerk will be integrating with [re:SearchTX](#) effective **FEBRUARY 18, 2025**.

Currently, only e-filed documents are available in re:SearchTX. By integrating, e-filed as well as paper-filed documents will be available in re:SearchTX.

Upon integration and in compliance with the Supreme Court Order, the clerks will no longer send to attorneys copies of orders, judgments, or notices in civil, family, and probate cases after **April 1, 2025**. You will not receive from the clerks any mail, email, or e-filed notices of civil settings, DWOP docket, signed orders/judgments for civil, family, and probate cases; your notification will be from re:SearchTX. **Therefore, it is very important that you register and sign up for alerts and notifications in re:SearchTX.**

Within re:SearchTX, for a fee, you can subscribe to case alerts for which you are not the attorney of record. Supreme Court Order Misc. Docket No. 24-9030 will now **alert parties and attorneys of record who have a registered account with re:SearchTX at NO CHARGE** for cases in which the county has integrated with re:SearchTX. You will have **free access** to documents for which you are the attorney of record.

At this time, criminal and juvenile cases are not available in re:SearchTX.

Availability and viewability of cases and documents are set out according to the Judicial Committee on Information Technology standards, [version 9.0 effective December 2024](#).

At this time, the [Parker County Secured Attorney Portal](#) is still available.

What does this mean for you?

1. Register with re:SearchTX and opt-in to receive Case Alerts and Notifications. Your login to re:SearchTX is the same as your login for E-File Texas.
2. Be sure to check emails from "noreply@research.txcourts.gov." These alerts and notifications include, but are not limited to signed orders, judgments, DWOP notices, and other notices.
