The Board of Emergency Services Commissioners (“Board”) of Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1 (“District”) convened in a Special Meeting on the 11 day of November 2025, at the regularly designated meeting place (“Meeting”), and the roll was called of the duly-constituted officers and members of the Board, to wit:

and all of said individuals were present, except _____, thus constituting a quorum for the purposes of the canvass of the November 4, 2025 Special Election of the District on the issue of adding a tract of land containing the Reno Fire Service Area to the Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1. Whereupon, the following was transacted at the Meeting: an

ORDER CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF PARKER COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 SPECIAL ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 4, 2025

was introduced for the consideration of the Board. It was then duly moved and seconded that the Order Canvassing the Returns and Declaring the Results of Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1 November 4, 2025 Special Election (“Order”) be adopted, and, after due discussion, the motion prevailed and carried unanimously.

2. A true, full, and correct copy of the Order adopted at the Meeting described in the above paragraph is attached hereto for all purposes; the Order has been duly recorded in the Board’s minutes of the meeting; the individuals in the above and foregoing paragraph are the duly appointed, qualified and acting officers of the District and Board as indicated herein; each of the officers and members of the Board was duly and sufficiently notified officially and personally, in advance, of the time, place, and purpose of the aforesaid Meeting and that the Order would be introduced and considered for adoption at the Meeting, and each of the officers and members consented, in advance, to the holding of

the meeting for such purpose; the meeting was open to the public as required by law; and public notice of the time, place and subject of the meeting was given as required by Chapter 551, Government Code.



**ORDER CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF
PARKER COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 NOVEMBER
4, 2025 SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE ANNEXATION OF THE RENO FIRE
SERVICE AREA**

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2025, an election was held in Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1 (“District”) to submit propositions on adding a tract of containing the Reno Fire Service Area (“Reno Service Area”) to the Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1; and,

WHEREAS, the votes cast at the election have been counted and recorded on the official election returns, and said returns have been certified and filed with the Board of Emergency Services Commissioners (“Board”) by the appropriate election officials; and

WHEREAS, the returns show the following number of votes cast at the election for the following propositions:

For the voters in the District:

PROPOSITION A:

For adding a tract of land located in the City of Reno, Texas, and adjacent territory, to Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1, only in Parker County, Texas.	6,789 votes
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Against adding a tract of land located in the City of Reno, Texas, and adjacent territory, to Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1, only in Parker County, Texas.	2,314 votes
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PROPOSITION B:

For the Reno Service Area assuming its proportionate share of the outstanding debts and taxes of the Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1, if it is added to the district.	7,044 votes
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Against The Reno Service Area assuming its proportionate share of the outstanding debts and taxes of the Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1, if it is added to the district.	1,994 votes
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For the voters in the Reno Service Area:

PROPOSITION AA:

For adding a tract of land located in the City of Reno, Texas, and adjacent territory, to Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1, only in Parker County, Texas. 255 votes

Against adding a tract of land located in the City of Reno, Texas, and adjacent territory, to Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1, only in Parker County, Texas. 169 votes

PROPOSITION BB:

For the Reno Service Area assuming its proportionate share of the outstanding debts and taxes of the Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1, if it is added to the district. 199 votes

Against The Reno Service Area assuming its proportionate share of the outstanding debts and taxes of the Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1, if it is added to the district. 219 votes

WHEREAS, the election was called and held in all respects under the strict conformity with the Constitutions and laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF EMERGENCY SERVICES COMMISSIONERS OF PARKER COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1:

Section 1. The Board held a duly called and properly noticed election on November 4, 2025 (“Election”) on the proposition of “Adding a tract of land located in the City of Reno, Texas, and adjacent territory, to Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1, only in Parker County, Texas,” and “The Reno Service Area assuming its proportionate share of the outstanding debts and taxes of the Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1, if it is added to the district,” and that such election was called and notice given in accordance with all applicable law, the election was held in conformity with all applicable law, and the returns of the election have been made by the proper officials in conformity with applicable law.

Section 2. The election has resulted in the addition of the tract of land located in the Reno Fire Service Area to the Parker County Emergency Services District No. 1, as set forth herein.

Section 3. The total number of votes cast in said Election in the District for and against Proposition A totaled 9,103.

Section 4. Proposition A was approved in the District by 4,475 votes.

Section 5. The total number of votes cast in said Election in the District for and against Proposition B totaled 9,038.

Section 6. Proposition B was approved in the District by 5,050 votes.

Section 7. The total number of votes cast in said Election in the Reno Fire Service Area for and against Proposition AA totaled 424.

Section 8. Proposition AA was approved in the Reno Fire Service Area by 86 votes.

Section 9. The total number of votes cast in said Election in the Reno Fire Service Area for and against Proposition BB totaled 418.

Section 10. Proposition BB was not approved in the Reno Fire Service Area by 20 votes.


Section 11. The District has complied with all applicable law in conducting a vote on the propositions, including, but not limited to, Chapter 775, Texas Health & Safety Code, and the Texas Election Code, and this Order is issued pursuant thereto.

Section 12. The Board finds the meeting at which this Order has been considered and adopted is open to the public as required, and written notice of the time, place and subject matter of the meeting, and of the proposed adoption of this Order, was given as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code. The Board confirms the written notice and the contents and posting thereof.
