Instructions for Registering a Mark/Brand

Cost

Marks	Brands
\$25.00 per mark, per species, per location. Ex: Cattle: Over 7, Pig: Under bit = \$50	\$25.00 per brand, per species, per location. Ex: "JWS w/Bar" Horse: L Hip, L Thigh = \$50 Ex: "JWS w/Bar" Horse: L Hip, Cattle: L Thigh, Goat: R Shoulder = \$75

Registering Online:

- You will need to download the application form and fill out all required information. You may type or write this information in, however, if you choose to write it please make sure it is legible or the application may be rejected.
- Once the form(s) are filled out for all marks/brands please go to the Certified Payments website (link is available on the Marks & Brands page of the Parker County website) and make your payment. Reference the chart above to determine what your total will be. *Certified Payments charges and additional \$2 to the total.
- Once your payment is complete, select the "print" option and download a PDF of the receipt to your device.
- Scan the filled-out form to your device (should be 2 pages with the signature on the second page) and save as a PDF.
- Attach both documents in an email and send to MarksandBrands@ParkerCountyTX.com
- Please allow at least 1 business day for review and approval of your brand application.
- Once your application is approved you will receive a copy in your email (to the one listed on the form) with the stamp and file information for your records.

Registering in Person:

- Forms are available in the County Clerk – Records & Deeds office located on 1112 Santa Fe Dr, Weatherford, TX in the Parker County Courthouse Annex Building. You can also print the form available online and bring it to the counter.
- Please allow about 10-15 minutes for review and approval at the counter.
- You may pay by card, cash, or check. Tap to pay is not available.
- Once approved you will receive the original signed document with the stamp and file information for your records before you leave.
