

RESOLUTION

Council of Judges, Parker County, Texas

Whereas, Parker County, Texas is a vibrant and growing county in Texas; and,

Whereas, Parker County has a quality of life second to none; and,

Whereas, one reason for said quality of life is quality law enforcement and respect for the law; and,

Whereas, the judicial system including all support agencies should operate efficiently to assure that respect for the law remains; and,

Whereas, in view of the significant growth in population in Parker County, there should be sufficient facilities for the courts, law enforcement, and juries; and,

Whereas, current facilities are not adequate to accommodate the court personnel, advanced electronic technology, litigants, security and inmate management, and juries; and,

Whereas, a new and modern justice center with adequate parking is needed now; and,

Whereas, the Council of Judges supports the Commissioners Court of Parker County in the planning and ultimate building of a justice center; and,

Whereas, said justice center should be large enough to accommodate all current and foreseeable future needs; and,


Whereas, land prices and interest rates are currently at the lowest point in recent memory; and,

Whereas, the Council of Judges adopted and submitted a similar resolution on September 15, 2009.


Now therefore, be it RESOLVED by the Council of Judges of Parker County, Texas that:


