
LOCAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULE – FAMILY LAW FILINGS

As the comment period has expired, as Local Administrative Judge of the District Courts in Parker County, Texas, I hereby issue this notice of a local rule with regard to the identification of parties in pleadings filed in family law cases. Effective as of October 20, 2015. (Note: this rule does not apply to the captions in adoption cases.)

LOCAL RULE:

As Texas Family Code Sections 102.008 and 105.006 requires the full names of the parties and the names and dates of birth of any minor children to be included in family law pleadings, the District Clerk is ordered to refuse to accept for filing any pleading that does not contain the required notice and/or contains only the initials of the parties or the children in the style.
