



Due to the increased number of campaign signs at polling places, Aledo ISD has established the following guidelines for electioneering and campaign signs at the Aledo ISD Administration Building polling place, based on Texas Election Code Section 61.003.

Sec. 61.003. ELECTIONEERING AND LOITERING NEAR POLLING PLACE

(a-1) The entity that owns or controls a public building being used as a polling place may not, at any time during the voting period, prohibit electioneering on the building's premises outside of the area described in Subsection (a), but may enact reasonable regulations concerning the time, place, and manner of electioneering.

Aledo ISD Administration Building Polling Place Regulations:

- Electioneering is prohibited on sidewalks and in drives on Aledo ISD property (including any driveway entrance to the Aledo ISD Administration Building).
- Each candidate is allowed no more than six (6) campaign signs (two (2) big and four (4) small) on Aledo ISD property, outside the one hundred (100) foot polling place distance marker.
- Campaign signs may not be placed in any location that will block/impede the line of sight at intersections/stop signs.
- Candidates may place their campaign signs after 5pm on Friday before the early voting period begins.
- Campaign signs shall be removed within 24 hours after polls close on Election Day.
