

SMALL CLAIMS

SMALL CLAIMS CASE: A small claims case is a lawsuit brought to recover money damages, civil penalties, personal property, or other relief allowed by law.

The claim can be for no more than **\$20,000**, excluding statutory interest and court costs but including attorney fees, if any.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE FILING PETITION

FOR INFORMATION ON THE RULES OF PRACTICE IN JUSTICE COURTS, PLEASE CONSULT PART V OF THE TEXAS RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE, WHICH IS AVAILABLE ONLINE AND AT EACH COURT.

THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS FURNISHED TO YOU AS A COURTESY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE PEACE OFFICE. THE COURT CANNOT ADVISE YOU WHAT YOU SHOULD DO AND ARE BARRED BY LAW FROM GIVING YOU LEGAL ADVICE. THE COURT CAN ONLY ANSWER PROCEDURAL QUESTIONS.

After the petition is completed, you will then be required to pay the filing fee of \$54.00 and the service for the citation of \$100.00 per person or entity you are suing. A citation along with a copy of your petition will be served to the defendant by the Constable or Sheriff's office notifying him that a suit has been filed against him in this court.

IT IS YOUR BURDEN AS PLAINTIFF TO MAKE SURE YOU ARE SUING THE DEFENDANT IN THEIR PROPER LEGAL CAPACITY. It is very important that you understand that for any potential judgment you may receive to be valid, it is necessary for you to sue the defendant in their *proper legal capacity*, of which there are typically three:

1. **Personally:** Where an individual is responsible to you for damages he may have caused you as an individual.

2. **Proprietor or partnership:** A business that is not incorporated, but does have on file with the County Clerk an assumed name, ex: John Smith dba Greenhouse Supplies.

3. **Corporation:** The business which has allegedly caused you damage is incorporated and therefore **it is necessary to know the individual's name who is authorized to accept civil process on behalf of the corporation.** The authorized agent for service would be listed with the Secretary of State, whose phone number is 1-800-252-5555, website is www.sos.state.tx.us
